Basic Rules and Regulations of Teaching Qaida

- Basic Rules and Regulations of Teaching Qaida, and Reciting new Lessons and Manzil.
- The rule of Tajweed has the status and importance of the spine in the field of the Qur'an. Therefore, those teachers who are familiar with the rules and regulations of Tajweed can pay their right.
- The Qaida of Tajweed should be taught by a teacher who has at least learned how to read and teach, from an expert teacher and has taken the Qaida course.
- The Qaida of Tajweed should be taught by the teacher whose heart is filled with the spirit of serving the Qur'an. Such lucky teachers should remember the following rules and regulations.
 - ❖ Give a new lesson as per ability.
 - ❖ Recite new lessons out loud and with Tajweed.
 - ❖ Get the student into the habit of reading repeatedly.
 - ❖ Explain specific Tajweed rules to intelligent students.
 - ❖ Listen to the new lessons from each student separately.
 - ❖ Don't overlook a minor mistakes.
 - ❖ Correct mistakes with sincerity and gently.
 - ❖ Strictly avoid bad words and anger during the Lesson/Class.
 - ❖ Develop the ability of children to take the correct tests/exams.
 - ❖ Make sure to listen to the previously learned lessons along with the new lesson.
 - ❖ When the new lesson is in the second lesson, listen to the first lesson.
 - ❖ When the new lesson is in the third Chapter, listen to the last one page as a lesson and all the remaining previous lessons from the beginning to the end as Manzil, and get the students in the mood to read it again and again.
 - ❖ After reading the four 4 pages of the Qaida, then all the students should have the habit of reciting one page as the lesson and three 3 pages as the Manzil and giving the exam.
 - ❖ When the seven 7 pages of Qaida have been read, students must have habit of reciting one page as lesson and all the other previous lessons in 2 days as Manzil, or reading it repeatedly and taking the exam with Tajweed.
 - ❖ When 10 pages of Qaida have been read, students must have habit of reciting one page is the lesson and all the other previous lessons should be recited in three days as Manzil, read and take the exam.
 - ❖ If the Chapter is completed, do not give the next lesson until student must pass the exam without any problems.

The importance and manners of prayer will be explained.

💡 Wise children aged 7-8 years can complete Tajweed Qaida in approximately 4 to 5 months, and children aged 4 to 5 months can do the same in 9 to 10 months

Note: At completion of Qaida, All student must be able

☞ to read Qaida with continues words.

☞ to read Qaida with fluency.

☞ to read Qaida with Tajweed.

☞ to read Quran Nazira.

Such children can, then complete Nazira Quran in approximately in 6 to 7 months with Tajweed.

Abstract: The children will be able to start Hifz e Quran in period of 1 year after completion of Qaida and Nazra.
